FOR WOMEN IN SCIENCE NATIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM L'ORÉAL TURKEY IN COLLABORATION WITH TURKISH NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR UNESCO

RULES AND REGULATIONS 2019

1. Introduction

L'ORÉAL UNESCO Fellowships for Women in Science are awards offered by a partnership between L'Oréal Turkey and the Turkish National Commission for UNESCO to promote, enhance and encourage the contribution of women pursuing their research careers in Turkey in the fields of the life and material sciences.

The National Fellowships Programme initiated in 2003 is continuing to promote women in scientific research on a global scale.

Six Fellowships will be awarded in 2019.

2. Fellowships

2.1. L'ORÉAL – UNESCO National Fellowship *For Women in Science* programme honors six young scientist each year. Three awards are given in Life Sciences and three awards are given in Material Sciences Category. Proposed research projects should focus on the specific listed below under Life and Material sciences heading:

Life Sciences: Biology, Molecular Biology, Genetics and Molecular Genetics, Biochemistry, Biophysics, Biotechnology, Pharmacology, Physiology, Bioinformatics including Health Informatics, Neurobiology, Biomedical and Artificial intelligence research in Biology.

Materials Sciences: Particulate Materials, Polymers, Glasses and Ceramics, Composites, Biomaterials, Nanomaterials, Specially Designed Surfaces, Photonic Crystals; Condensed Matter Physics and Statistical Physics.

- 2.2. Each candidate should hold a doctoral degree (Ph.D.) to apply to the fellowship program. Each Fellow is granted 75.000 TL. The fellowship program is open to scientists with a doctoral or a post-doctoral degree under 40 years of age at the date of 31st December 2018 (last day of the announcement year).
- 2.3. The recipients of the fellowships shall be publicly announced in an official ceremony (the venue and date thereof to be determined separately).

3. Submission of Applications for Fellowship

3.1. Applications can only be made through the online platform <u>http://www.forwomeninscience.com/en/fellowships</u> by the candidates themselves starting from November 24, 2018 till 20th of February 2019 at the latest. Applications shall be written in English and theymust contain the following components and in the order below:

- A copy of Turkish Identity Card (ID) indicating that the applicant is a citizen of the Republic of Turkey;
- Filled application form;
- A detailed Curriculum Vitae in Turkish includes a current photograph of the applicant;
- Copies of the documents confirming educational achievement and academic degrees (will be in Turkish);
- Description of the proposed research project (1 2 pages in Turkish) for a period of one year;
- A support letter from the scientific institution (The letter of support should be signed by the head of the applicant's institution), where the project is being carried out and which facilities will be provided by the scientific institution (will be in Turkish);

- List of scientific publications and patents;
- Copies of maximum five publications or web links to their full text which the applicant considers as significant;
- A copy of signed ethics committee report (If the research project includes human and/or animal experiments, ethics committee report should be taken with the same title of the project);
- Detailed budget proposal (in Turkish Lira);
- Data Protection document (downloaded, signed and uploaded back to the system).
- 3.2. Incomplete files received after the deadline for application, as well as candidatures that do not meet the requirements mentioned above, will not be taken into consideration.
- 3.3. The project proposal should be planned to be carried out individually by the applicant. The proposed project should not be planned as a thesis study to be conducted by the applicant.
- 3.4. Project proposals should not be related research on cosmetics.
- 3.5. Project proposals should not be planned to create a laboratory infrastructure.
- 3.6. The service procurements of the project proposal should not exceed one third of the total budget.
- 3.7. Candidates whose applications are not positively selected in the past application periods, may only apply to the fellowship one more time with a different research project content.

4. Procedure for the Review of Fellowship Applications

4.1. Each project will be assessed by independent jury (Turkish National Commission for UNESCO).

5. Selection Criteria

- 5.1. The selection criteria of the candidate by the Jury are following:
 - The candidate's outstanding academic records (including number, quality and impact of the publications (impact factors to be submitted), conference presentations, patents...);
 - The scientific quality of the research project;
 - The innovative nature and productivity of the research and its potential application;
 - The ability of the candidate to communicate and promote science to a younger audience and to encourage young female scientists;
 - Relevance and importance of the research for the national and international society.
- 5.2. Fellowships are non-renewable.

6. Announcement of Fellowship Award

6.1. The decision of the Fellowship Jury with respect to the applications shall be communicated to the applicants via writing and phone call within a period of one week after the adoption of the decision. The list of the fellowship recipients shall be announced to the mass media.

7. Conditions for Award the Fellowship

7.1. The fellowship shall be awarded based on relevance, quality and expected impact of the recipient's scientific research, with the purpose to financially support the recipient in pursuing her career in the field of scientific research and/or development in concerned country. The fellowship recipient shall undertake to pursue this research for a period of one year in accordance with her submitted application, and, upon the expiry of this term, to submit a brief progress report to the founders and partners of the fellowship.

- 7.2. The fellowship recipients shall undertake to acknowledge the receipt of a fellowship in all publications that will be generated as a result of the above mentioned research.
- 7.3. The fellowship recipients must take part in the official awarding ceremony in İstanbul (with the venue and date thereof to be determined separately).
- 7.4. Fellowships shall be disbursed as 2 instalments after the official awarding ceremony and after the recipient signing the agreement with *L'OREAL TURKEY*.
- 7.5. Fellowship can be used only for referenced project.
- 7.6. The fellowship recipient hereby agrees to be photographed, filmed and interviewed in media within the scope of communication of the Fellowship Programme and hereby gives her consent to the free-of-charge use of these photos, recorded material and interviews in the communication pertaining to the above-mentioned programme in Turkey and countries abroad.
- 7.7. The fellowship recipient shall immediately inform the fellowship commission if she changes her place of work or research and / or gives up pursuing the scientific project within a period of one year after the fellowship has been awarded.
